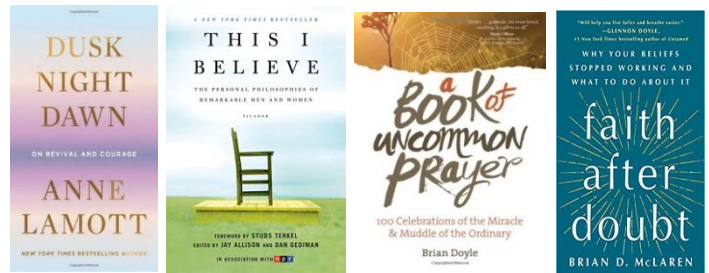

### GO GETTER LUNCHEON, JUNE 13

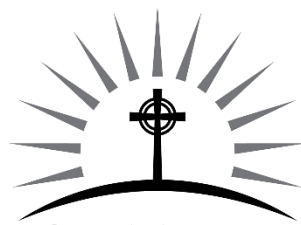
The last Go Getter luncheon before a summer break will be held at Candicci's Restaurant, 100 Holloway Rd., Ballwin, MO at 12 pm.
