

## Tuition and Fees 2024-2025

Tuition is paid in 9 installments, due the first of the month, August through April.

\*Lunch Bunch extends a child's day 1.5 hours and costs \$10 a session. Sign-ups take place on a monthly basis.

The 2024-2025 school year will run from August 26th to May 15th.
