#### **PASTOR'S OFFICE HOURS**



## ONE GREAT HOUR OF SHARING – DISASTER ASSISTANCE

Disaster Assistance covers more than hurricanes and earthquakes, although there is a lot of work to be done there. Currently PDA is addressing issues around the flooding in Pakistan, war in Ukraine, Typhoon Rai in the Philippines, tropical storms in Madagascar and Malawi, drought in East Africa and many more. There is also involvement with refugees—housing and food—even in the US for the influx of refugees being evacuated from Afghanistan, assistance for migrant shelters, transit ministries, etc...

\$3.1 million has been utilized in 35 countries. 228,318 Gift of the Heart Kits and Blankets have been distributed. But those actions cover a small part of what PDA provides to the local area.

PDA's specialty is long-term response, and its partner ministries in the Presbyterian Mission Agency and the Office of the General Assembly are part of a broad, sustained response, as well as advocacy offices in Washington, at the United Nations and Presbyterian World Mission.



During the season of Lent, Pastor Dave challenges the congregation to read passages from the gospels of Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John each day of the forty days of Lent. See the back of the bulletin for your guide to reading four gospels in forty days.



Pastor Dave encourages us to drink only clean tap water




