PEACE AND GLOBAL WITNESS -

Presbyterian Children's Home and Services
Half of the twenty-five percent of the Peace and
Global Witness Offering that is collected at St. Mark
is sent to Presbyterian Children's Home and Services.

Presbyterian Children's Home and Services has numerous initiatives. One of those works with older foster youth who are aging out of the system. They are supported through group homes, apartment residences, life skills training, gaining employment, and becoming prepared for independent adult living.

The program is not an emergency shelter and only accepts clients through an application, interview, and assessment process. With limited supervision, a transitional living curriculum is used to help struggling youth grow and accomplish their goals. The program aims to provide them with an effective, results-driven bridge between living in foster care and living on their own.

Be part of that process by participating in the Peace and Global Witness Special Offering. Use the envelope in your monthly packet or just make a note on your check in the offering plate.


USHERS NEEDED!
