## MISSION PARTNER REQUESTS FOR BACK TO SCHOOL

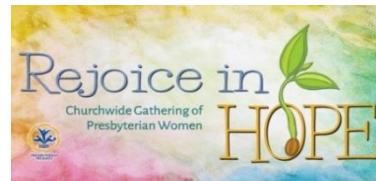


Seriously! It is that time again! To have enough supplies for the upcoming school year, our mission partners have reached out to St. Mark to request priority items.
