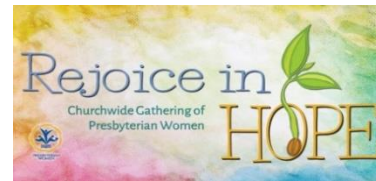


KNIGHTS OF THE NORTH CASTLE VBS & CASTLE OF CANS DONATIONS
