MUSIC NOTES

From Mark 13:7 "When you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be alarmed." Today's anthem, **One Song** by Choplin, is a reflection and hymn of hope on this text drawn from today's liturgical new testament reading. 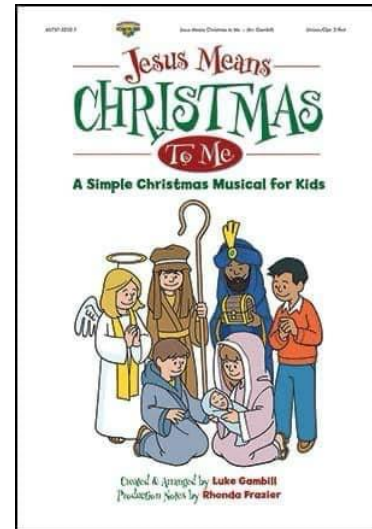
CHRISTMAS POINTSETTIAS

Bears will be available for ordering and pick-up at the PW Table in the Narthex. Order your bears today.

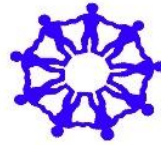
LOCAL FOOD PANTRY INVENTORIES DROPPING
